

Focus your video on ICE agent rather than the person being detained

## REMINDERS

- **Stay at a safe distance and do not interfere**
  - If you are told to step back, do so while saying: "I am exercising my right to record."
  - If the officers get too close, narrate that you are stepping back in a calm, audible voice
- **Focus your recording on the ICE officers**
  - Record all the way through the incident if possible and narrate what you're seeing
- **Do not document/narrate the following**
  - Community members' names, immigration status, criminal history, or A number
- **If ICE asks for or tries to take your phone, do not physically resist**
  - Say: "I don't consent to giving you my phone and I don't consent to a search of my phone."
- **Your role is documentation, not intervention**
  - Observe, document, and report. Your calm presence and accurate documentation can help protect community!



Stay Calm. Remember, you can't help anyone if your adrenaline is rushing and you are scattered

### Why Record Ice Activity?

- To collect information that could help an affected community member's legal case.
- Documentation plays a crucial role in exposing law enforcement abuses and advocating for rights.
- To inform rights groups so they may alert community about ICE activity.

### Reminder to ICE Agents:

"You're a federal agent operating in a public space. We have the right to record, document, and ask you to identify yourself as you fulfill your duties."

*Never go live or post to social media, allow for AARRN to confirm activity*

## If you see suspected ICE activity

**Step 1** – Put on a Mask (optional based on personal risk preferences)

**Step 2**- Take Video/Pictures & Document Details (SALUTE)

**Step 3** – Call FPI Hotline 410-222-0319\*

**Step 4** – Continue to document ICE agents and vehicles

**Step 5** – Afterwards send videos, photos and details to number provided by FPI

\* If ICE is actively detaining, record BEFORE calling

**Please do not use whistles.**

## Document Details using SALUTE

### S.A.L.U.T.E DOCUMENTATION

**S**-Size → How many agents/ officers/vehicles?

**A**-Activity → What are the agents doing? Knocking on doors? Detaining someone? Attempting to enter private property?

**L**-Location → Give an exact address, intersection and/or landmark.

**U**-Unit(s) → What letters, details, or patches are visible on the uniforms/jackets/vests/vehicles? Plainclothes? Masked? Pretending to be police? Refused to identify themselves?

**T**-Time → What is the date and time? This info should be shared quickly.

**E**-Equipment → What did agents have with them? Any weapons, flexicuffs, dogs, door breakers, LRAD sound cannon, vans, SUVs, etc. Document vehicle details especially plates!

## Family Protection Initiative: 410-222-0319

**You won't be able to stop the detaining; however, you can still help. Quickly ask for their Name and Emergency Contact; nothing more.**

If someone is being detained from a residential home, don't give that address, give closest intersection.

## If You See a Detention Taking Place

### What to say (English)

*"I'm just reminding you..."*

- You have the right to remain silent.
- Ask to see a judicial warrant.
- You have the right to contact your attorney.
- You do not need to sign anything.

*"I'm recording because I'm concerned for your safety."*

If able, ask\*:

- What's your first and last name/ID?
- Who can I contact for you?

### Qué decir (Español)

*"Solo te estoy recordando..."*

- ¡Tienes derecho de permanecer en silencio!
- ¡Pide ver una orden judicial!
- ¡Tienes derecho a contactar a tu abogado!
- ¡No necesitas firmar nada!

*"Estoy grabando porque estoy preocupado por tu seguridad."*

Si puedes, pregunta:

- ¡Cuál es tu nombre y apellidos?
- ¡A quién puedo contactar para usted?
